Katabanut is named after the king parrots who inhabit the surrounding trees and it provides the most perfect nest to escape to. Architecturally designed and built in the 1980s, it has been lovingly looked after by one family who have lived like custodians of the land, nurturing and caring for it at every corner.

A pretty covered deck leads to a large, sun-filled open-plan living room and kitchen with views taking in the woodland and breaking waves below. Inside are three roomy bedrooms, a bathroom, WC and laundry. This property is self-sufficient in that it captures the solar energy for power and uses water that has fallen as rain and is kept in large tanks; it is environmentally friendly living at its best.

Outside, there are 40 acres to explore bordering National Park and state owned forest. Near the house is a native
